Dear Parents and Carers,

As you know, our summer term is always packed full of fun with lots of different events. Although dates have been on our newsletter for a while, we wanted to give you more information about some of the inschool events coming up...

Sports Days

<u>Nursery</u> (Wednesday 21st May) and <u>Reception</u> (Thursday 22nd May). Please see the separate letters you have received.

The KS1 and KS2 Sports Day and Picnic (Wednesday 18th June)

If you have not been to our KS1 and KS2 Sports Day and Picnic previously, we have KS1 (Years 1 and 2) sports in the morning and KS2 (Years 3 to 6) sports in the afternoon. In between we have a picnic on the field. If you have a child in KS1 you are invited to be with us for the morning and picnic, if you have a child in KS2 you are invited for the picnic and afternoon... and if you are lucky enough to have children in both you can stay for the full day! During the picnic time the children are signed over to you and are your responsibility and must be supervised at all times.

- KS1 Sports will begin at 10:30am and finish at approximately 11:50am. KS1 children then go back inside.
- The KS1/KS2 picnic will start at approximately 12:15pm and finish at 1:00pm.
- All children go back inside at this point. KS1 children begin their afternoon learning and KS2 children then return.
- KS2 Sports will begin at 1:30pm and finish at approximately 2:50pm.
- KS2 children go back inside and are then collected following usual arrangements.

Further details about the KS1 and KS2 Sports Day and Picnic will follow after the May half-term holiday.

Obviously, as you will understand, all of the sports events are weather dependent. If the weather forecasts ahead of our events look very unfavourable we will have no choice but to postpone to another day.

Open Evening (Thursday 3rd July)

This is an opportunity for you to visit your child's classroom to look at their learning from the year and to talk with staff. At the Open Evening, we will have the Portico Art & Design Festival on display, showcasing work from across the five schools in our Trust.
