- 5. Work closely with other members of the School Council, understanding and demonstrating the importance of teamwork and effective communication.
- 6. Demonstrate exemplary conduct both in and out of the school, acting as an excellent role model for others.
- 7. Uphold, demonstrate and promote the school values.
- 8. Meet with visitors to the school when asked to do so, as well as representing the school at events.
