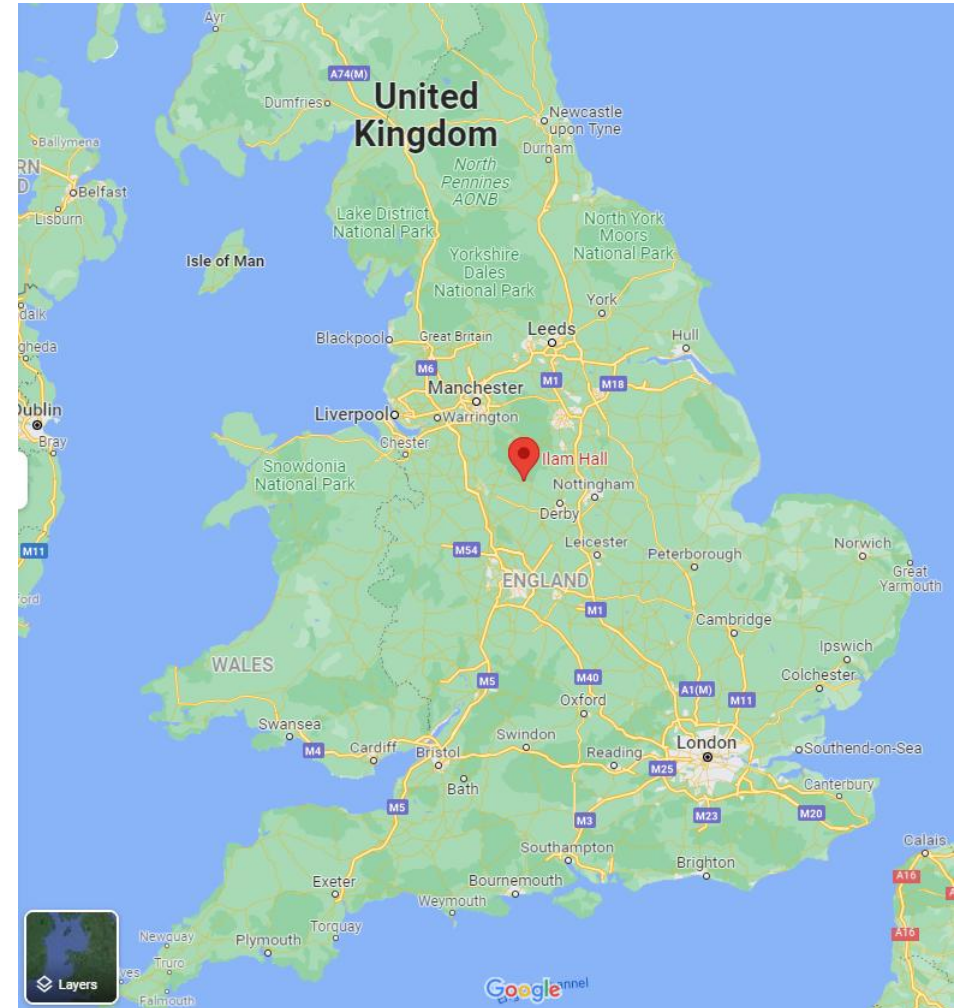

The Peak District is a fantastic area of England with lots of things to see and do!



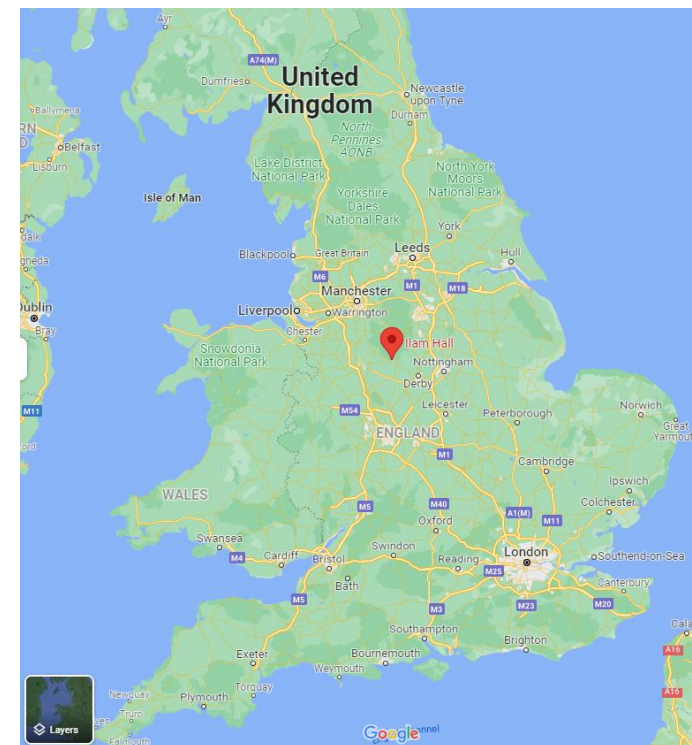
Coach Journey

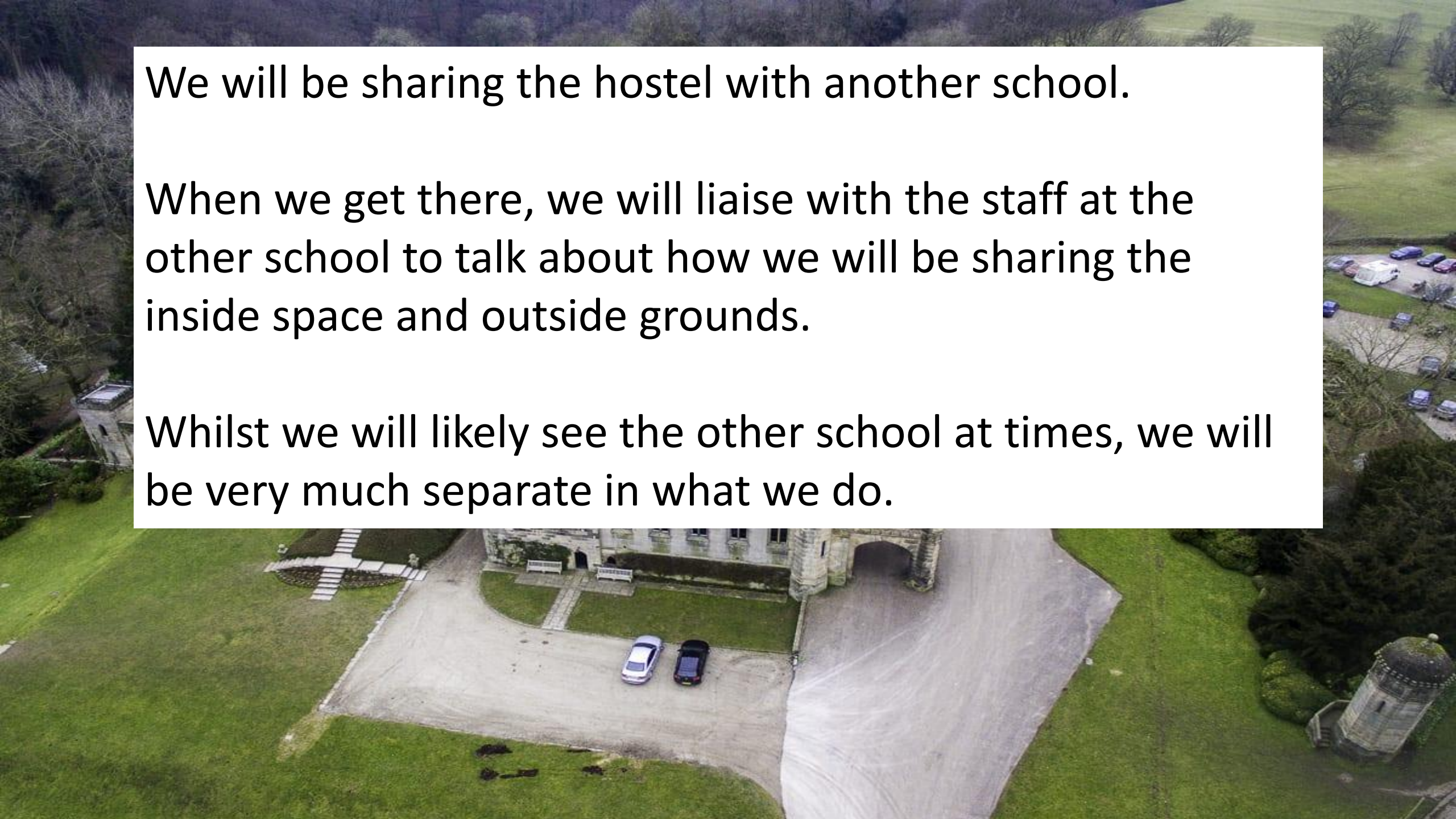


Ilam Hall Youth Hostel

Bedrooms

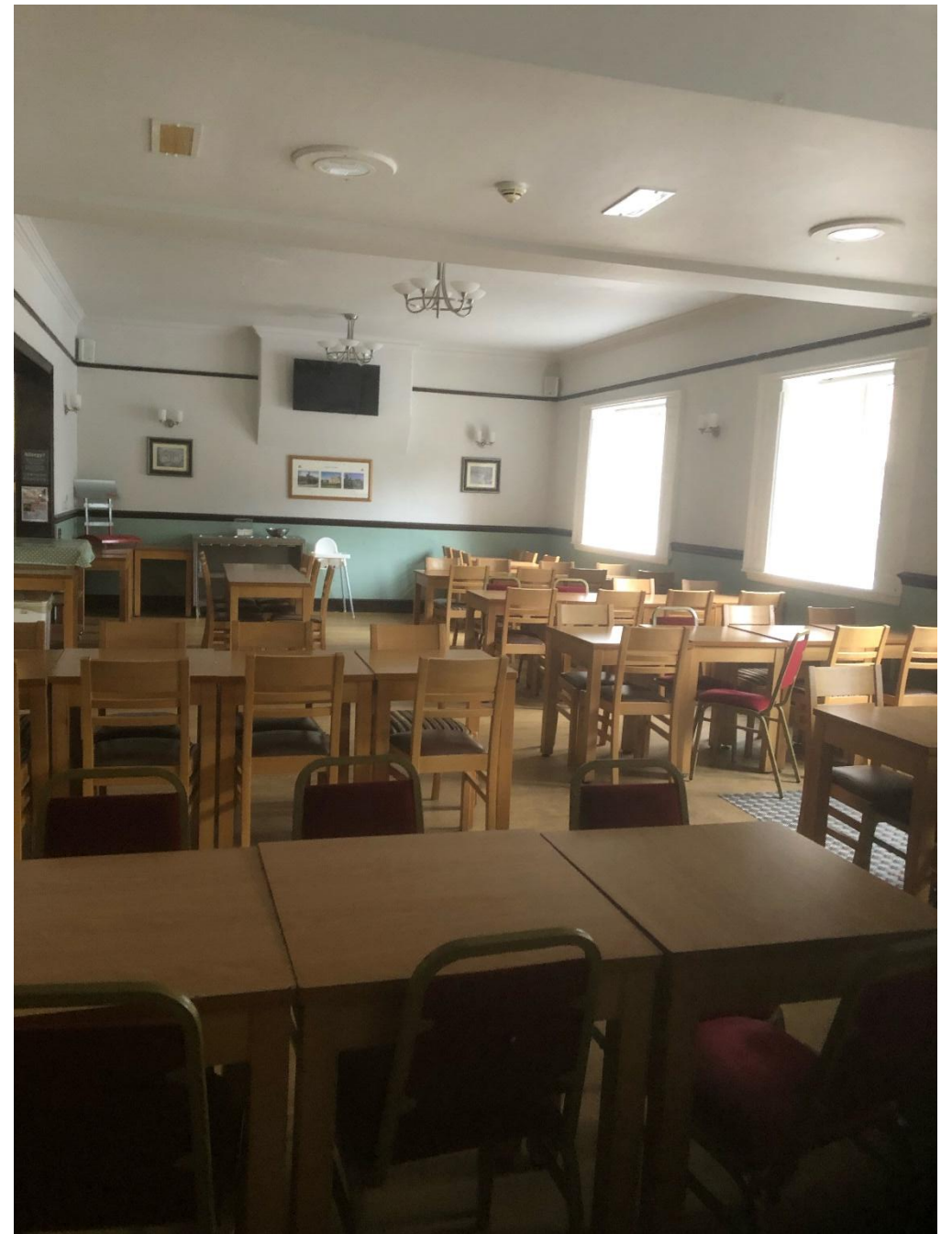

- Packed lunch for the journey there
- Socks (plenty of them) and underwear
- T-shirts
- Warm tops/fleece
- Jeans/jogging bottoms etc
- Sturdy, comfortable trainers
- Another pair of trainers to wear around the hostel (could be Crocs or something similar)
- Sleepwear
- Waterproof jacket/cagoule (must fit in rucksack)
- Watch
- Water bottle
- Sun cream and sun hat
- Backpack to hold enough for the day
- Secure wallet or purse for cash
- Towel and washbag to include: soap or shower gel, shampoo, toothbrush and toothpaste, deodorant and a hairbrush/comb

Things to bring...

You need enough spares of the above to last you for 5 days.

It could be hot or cold, or wet or dry – or all of these things together so come prepared!

You will want to change when you get back to the hotel into different clothes.

You should **not** bring any electronic items – this includes a camera. The staff will take lots and lots of photos and we will share these with you...

Everything must fit into your daily backpack and either a suitcase or holdall. You must be able to carry them yourself, so leave the kitchen sink at home!

Other things to possibly bring:

- Snacks – but there will be plenty of food
- Sweets but not too many!
- Reading/wordsearch book/Top Trumps etc.
- Travel sickness tablets – enough for the week
- Teddy bear – not the most precious

Spending Money

- The children can bring up to £30 spending money. They can have up to £5 of this on them for the Monday.
- The rest of the money (£25) should be put into a named envelope and given to either Mrs. Bailey or Mrs. Stubbs **by Monday 8th June**. Ideally please use £5 notes.
- The spending money will be kept by Mr. McClay and each morning, Mr. McClay will run the 'bank' and sign money out. Once the children have the money it is their responsibility.
- The children must not loan money to friends.
- Talk to the children about what they are allowed to spend their money on...

- It won't be a surprise that the children are not allowed to bring mobile phones.
- We will encourage the children to write postcards home. The children will need to buy the postcard – we will supply the stamp.

- We will send daily updates of how we're doing. This will be by a Facebook post/email. We try to include a few photographs.

- Please remember that we will be kept very busy looking after the children and keeping them entertained. The internet signal can also be very temperamental in Ilam, as the hall sits in a valley surrounded by hills.
